We also operate our own extrusion plant in Cambridgeshire, manufacturing a quality ingredient used in our poultry diets.

Role Profile

The Quality Co-ordinator is a pivotal role supporting both the Technical team and Operations to achieve the highest levels of feed quality and safety. Ensuring the compliance with strict quality control procedures at all times, in order to deliver business objectives.

A key aspect of this role is the responsibility for the application and maintenance of the quality and audit standards for the whole manufacturing process at all times. You will continually address non-conformances and have the initiative and problem-solving skills to come up with new and effective corrective processes. Day to day you will then be expected to assess the facility against the standard operating procedures and work instructions, feeling comfortable to provide clear instructions to others in order to ensure everyone is aware and adhering.

You will also carry out sampling and analysis of quality samples of ingredients, finished feed, and the environment. This will involve being present and hands on in the mill, then going on to produce high standard reports interpreting the results which you will relay to both internal and external parties. If there is anything outside of agreed parameters within the data results you will carry out in depth investigations to identify possible causes and come up with new ideas to improve in future. You will also work closely with the laboratory team and offer support when necessary.

With time spent in the plant, lab and on desk functions this is an exciting opportunity to be part of all aspects of feed production.

Essential Skills and Experience Required

To be successful in this role, the desired candidate should preferably hold strong experience within a team-based manufacturing or production environment, working proactively with strict safety and quality control procedures and KPIs.

This job would suit a hands-on team player with a high attention to detail. We are looking for a confident, organised, and approachable individual with focus on process improvement and problem solving, to work as part of a multi-functional team.
