### Role Profile

Reporting to the Mill Manager, this role will be responsible for generating and promoting a positive Quality, Health & Safety culture within the workplace.

You will manage the Quality Standards required to make safe high-quality feed. You will be responsible for the quality data reporting and assist with audit requirements whilst always ensuring compliance with strict quality control procedures. You will advise on all aspects of Health & Safety, ensuring compliance with health & safety legislation and adherence to best practice at all times in order to deliver business objectives.

Within this role you will proactively engage and educate all 2Agriculture employees on the importance and relevance of Quality and Safety, delivering safety awareness programmes as required, whilst supporting the implementation of the Environmental policy and associated procedures. You will be actively involved in the implementation and maintenance of an effective Risk Management system, proactively identifying areas of

concern to Health & Safety, escalating where necessary and following up to ensure corrective actions are implemented.

An essential aspect of this role is to manage the sites accident reporting system, carrying out thorough investigation and corrective action, as necessary. You will be required to maintain audit standards and professionally represent the company with external and regulatory bodies as required, securing the relevant operation permits to ensure legal compliance.

Your daily duties will also include supporting the induction process of new employees by delivering training from a quality and safety perspective. Consistently supporting the development and maintenance of equipment and systems to secure the protection of our people and effectively utilising the allocated budget whilst leading and implementing key Quality, Health & Safety projects.

### **Essential Skills and Experience Required**

To be successful in this role, the desired candidate should have proven experience as a Health, Safety and Environmental specialist, involving leading HSE projects, delivering positive outputs for the business and delivering HSE based internal training.

You should have strong, demonstrable experience in managing the auditing process and a track record of enabling full compliance in both internal and external audits. You should be confident in managing accident reporting systems, undertaking investigations, and implementing corrective actions. We are looking for someone who is able to motivate and empower others and makes prompt clear decisions which may involve tough choices or considered risks whilst taking responsibility for their actions. This is a fast-paced and dynamic environment which requires a keen eye for detail.

A NEBOSH National certificate in occupational health and safety and minimum GCSE level C or equivalent in Maths and English is essential. In addition to this, experience within a production environment and a NEBOSH or IOSH Environmental Management certificate would be advantageous. You should also have an excellent knowledge of IT systems and management of HSE databases along with a Level 3 HACCP for Food Manufacturing at a minimum.
