Key Role Objectives

To manage operation of the farm to produce desired results in line with business strategy including, ensuring that the stock produced is of the highest standards and meets the required specification in terms of welfare, weight, quality, and cost efficiency.

Key Accountabilities / Responsibilities

- Communicate with Area Manager ensuring relevant information is provided promptly and accurately alerting AM when problems on farm are identified.
- Ensure bird welfare is never compromised.
- Manage and monitor ventilation, heating, feed, water, litter, and lighting within the agreed standards, ensuring the highest quality conditions are provided for the birds.
- Responsibility for ensuring biosecurity measures are adhered to Ensure all company and external assurance schemes/standards are met at all times.
- Ensure weekly paperwork is accurately recorded and sent on time to the relevant Department.
- Cover and test the alarm ensuring it is operational, and any faults rectified immediately.
- Ensure site security is maintained at all times, while reporting any issues to Area Manager.
- Ensure site is maintained in clean, tidy, and presentable manner.
- Ensure Company Health & Safety Policy is adhered to at all times.
- Ensure that all Codes of Practice are adhered to at all times.
- Manage and control Contractors on site ensuring work is conducted to the required specification and quality.
- Responsible for day-to-day management of farm Employees, including allocation of work to ensure smooth running of farm.
- Responsible for induction and training of new Employees.
- Monitor and report sickness and other Employee issues when they happen, and ensure appropriate cover is in place.
- Responsible for accurate completion of Employee timesheets, including on time submission.
- Undertake any other duties as required to fulfil the needs of the position.
- Attend training courses which are deemed appropriate by the Company and the Industry Standard Poultry Passport requirements.

Essential Knowledge, Skills, and Experience

- Initiative and influencing skills with a critically evaluating and questioning approach.
- Sound stock management background
- Ability to manage staff.
- Organised and detailed approach to duties
- Ability to prioritise duties / tasks.
- Ability to work as part of a team as well as on own initiative.
- Flexible approach will be necessary as this role will necessitate working at weekends with a requirement for early morning and late evening work.
